12<sup>th</sup>. Heavenly Father, we pray for those, who find it difficult to trust in a loving God.

13<sup>th</sup> Father God, we lift before you all who are suffering in Gaza.

14<sup>th</sup> Father God, we thank you that each soul is precious to you. Help us to remember that your love extends to all.
